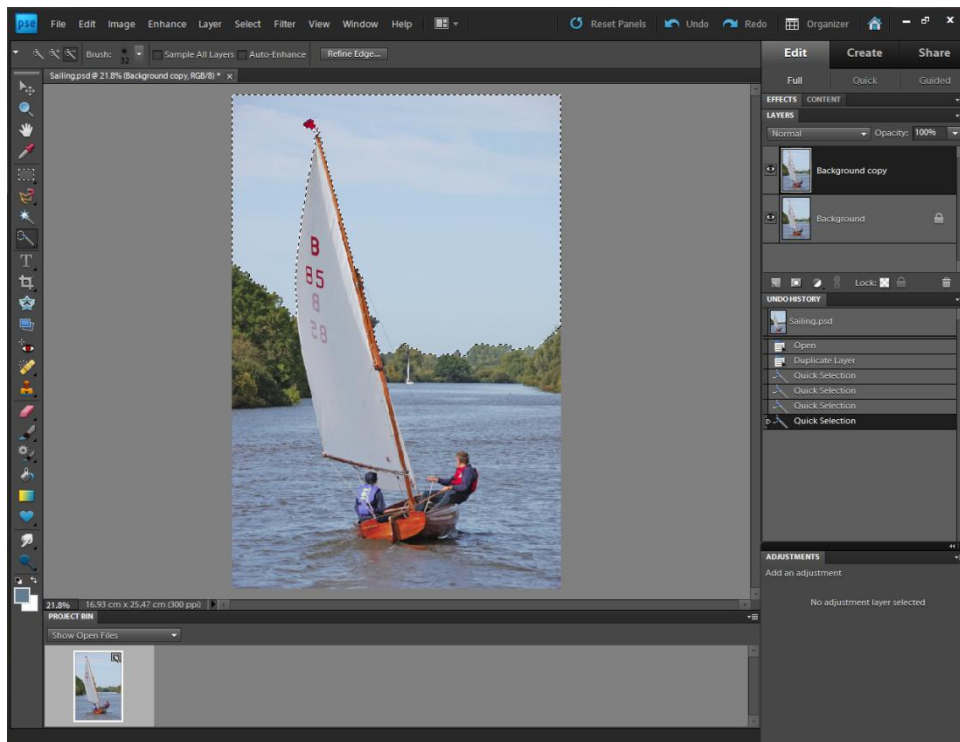
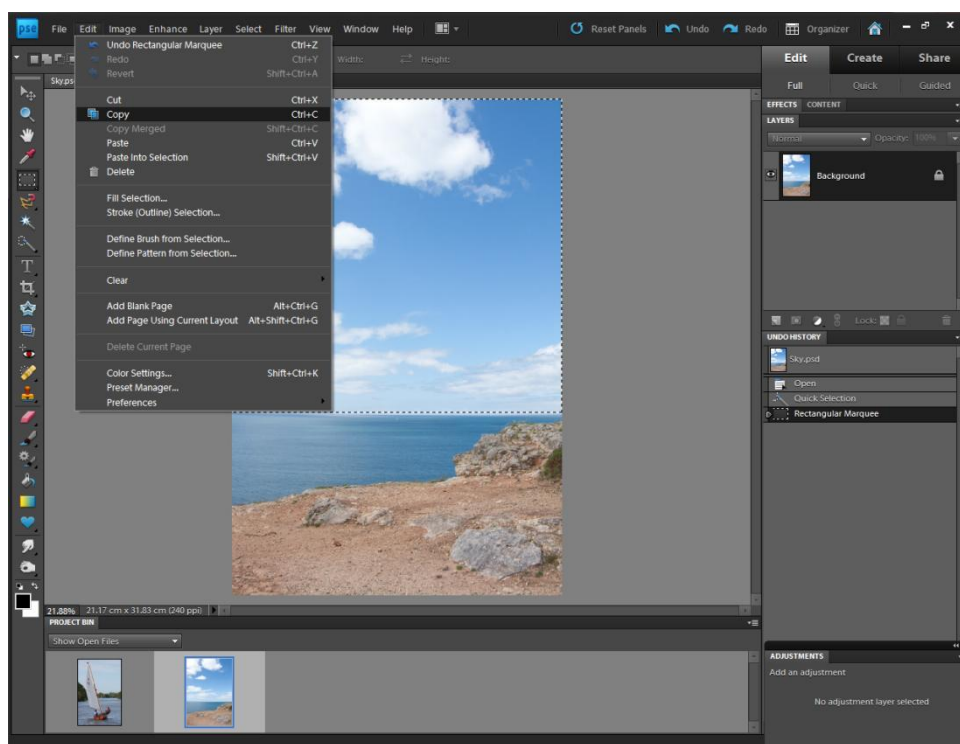


Replacing the Sky (Photoshop Elements)

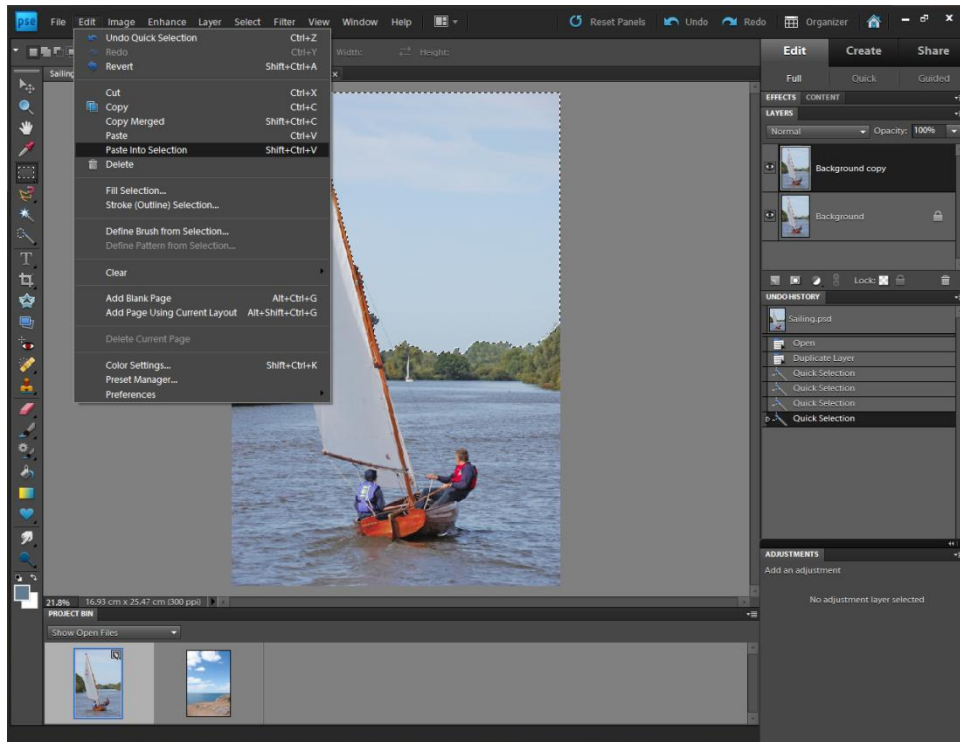
Open the file, make a duplicate layer and select the sky.



Open the 'sky' image. Check that the sizes of the two images match. Use a rectangular marquee to outline the area of sky to be used. **Edit > Copy**.




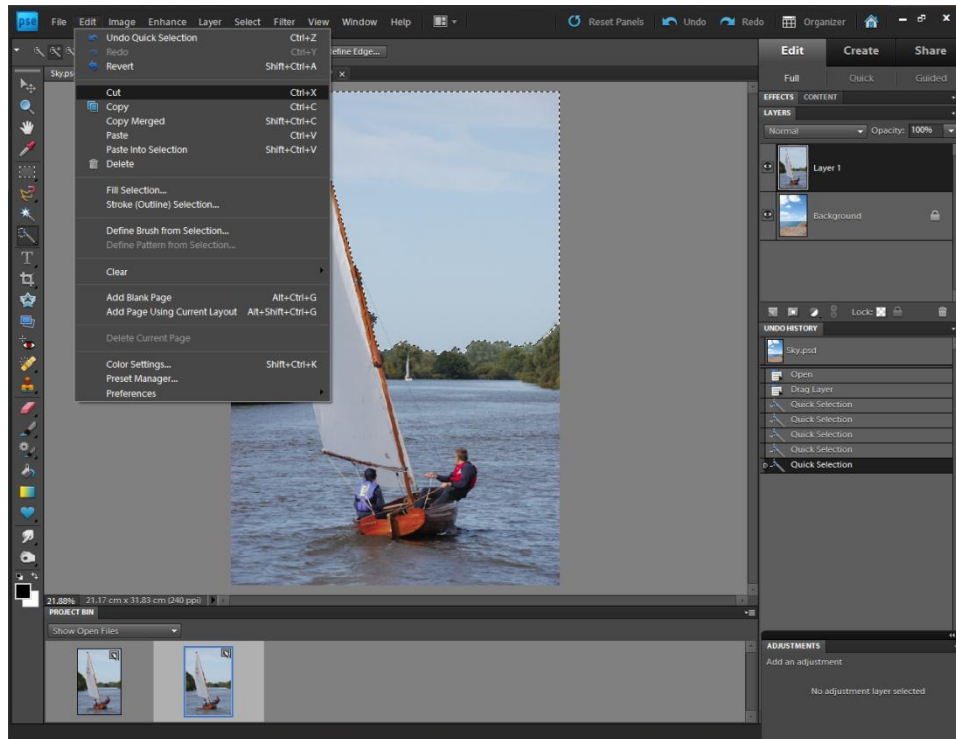
Change back to the original image. **Edit > Paste into Selection.**



Save the new image.



Perhaps a better way is one that keeps the two images on separate layers to make subsequent manipulation easier. Open both files and use the Move tool  to drag and drop the main image on top of the sky image. Use a selection tool to select the sky area on the main image then **Edit > Cut** to remove the old sky and allow the lower image to show through. You can also use a layer mask as described in the HDR worksheet.
